

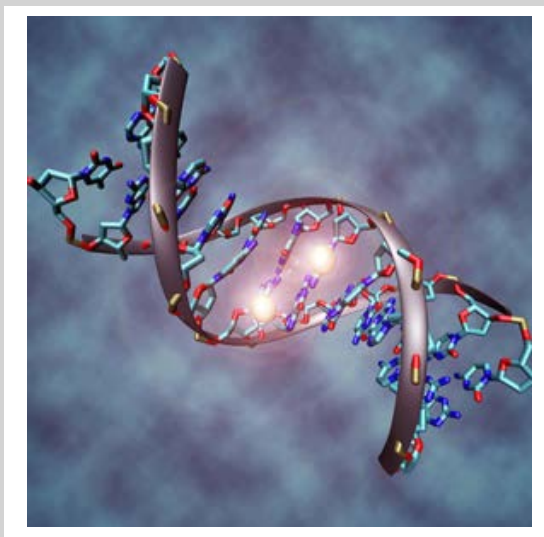

humans?

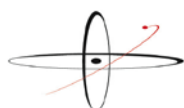


Keith Fox is Professor of Biochemistry at the University of Southampton.
